



Translating Insights into Concepts

In the "See Me, Hear Me, Know Me" project, five participants shared their experiences of having multiple chronic health conditions, the challenges they faced, and the difficulty of conveying these experiences to others.

Working closely with the researcher, they codesigned five interactive, digital prototypes which demonstrate their stories and show each participant's future vision for a health storytelling tool. The project also developed a set of requirements and design guidelines for creating applications for health storytelling.

In addition to the finished thesis, the findings from the Masters project were published in two different academic journals. The requirements and guidelines are also being used by DHI to further other personcentred digital work.
